Dear Parents and Carers

Please find attached the final report from the Ofsted inspection that took place at St Peter's on 27th and 28th September 2017.

Your attention will be drawn, no doubt, to the fact that the overall judgement of the inspection team remained that St Peter's requires improvement. However, I would strongly advise you to read the full report to get a comprehensive and accurate picture of the strong position in which the school currently finds itself. The majority of the report's content is positive about the work of the school. The commentary does highlight areas where practice in the classroom, leading to better pupil outcomes, still needs to be of a more consistently high standard. It is to be noted that St Peter's Senior Leadership Team and Governors had identified all of these areas as points for action on the School Improvement Plan for 2017/2018, and work was already underway to address these across the curriculum when the inspection took place.

The report also makes mention of the extensive changes that have taken place in the school over the past two years, and acknowledges the impact that these have had on St Peter's. A comparison of this report and the July 2015 report will give a clear indication of the work that has been done and the progress that has been made over the past two years, and which is continuing still. This hard work is being done by a teaching team and school staff that is fully committed to securing the best outcomes for the children at St Peter's.

Finally, I must commend the good behaviour and mature conduct that the pupils showed during the inspection. They were a credit to their families and their teachers, and gave the very best impression of St Peter's to the inspectors.
