Dear Parents and Carers

Please find attached the final letter from the Ofsted Monitoring Visit that took place at St Peter's on 7th November 2018.

At our last full inspection in September 2017, the school was tasked to

Improve the quality of teaching and raise pupils' performance, particularly in mathematics, by ensuring that:

- teachers use assessment information effectively to build on what pupils already know and can do*
- teachers plan suitably challenging activities for the most able pupils and support them to master new topics during lessons*
- teachers check pupils' level of understanding regularly throughout lessons and reshape tasks when pupils are ready to move on*
- best practice is shared across the school.*

The monitoring visit letter of November 2018 makes clear the extensive progress that the school has made in these areas since September 2017. Acknowledging that there is work still to be done to make these improvements permanent features at St Peter's, we are very proud of the progress the school and its pupils have made over the past year. This is in no small part due to the hard work that is being done by a quality teaching team, and school staff that are fully committed to securing the best outcomes for the children at St Peter's. Equally, the dedication of the pupils to their learning and progress rightly deserves to be praised.

Finally, I must commend the good behaviour and mature conduct that the pupils showed during the inspection. They were a credit to their families and their teachers, and gave the very best impression of St Peter's to the inspector, Sir Robin Boshier.
